
Light box screen film process

Preparation


- 1. Clean the light box surface: Wipe the surface with a clean cloth dampened with water or cleaner to ensure it is free of dust.
- 2. Check the water transfer film: Ensure the film is intact and properly sized. Trim if necessary.
- 3. Prepare tools: Have a spray bottle (filled with water), scraper, towel or sponge, and utility knife ready.

Application Process


1. Moisten the light box: Spray the surface of the light box with water to create a thin film.




2. Peel off the backing: Carefully peel off part of the backing from the water transfer film and align it with the light box surface.



3. Apply the film:Start from one end and use the scraper to smooth out the film, removing any bubbles and ensuring a tight bond.



4. Trim excess: Use a utility knife to cut away any excess film that extends beyond the light box surface.



Post-Application

- 1. Inspect the result:Check if the film is securely attached and free of bubbles or wrinkles.
- 2. Dry:Allow the light box to air dry in a ventilated area, avoiding direct sunlight.
- 3. Clean up:Tidy up the tools and work area.
